Who can apply?

To apply for an apprenticeship, we require all applicants to have a minimum of five GCSE's at grade 4 - 9 (A* - C), which includes Maths and English. Level 4 and above programmes will require you to have a-Levels or equivalent learning. Each apprentice programme typically takes between two and six years to complete.

It means you can look to the future. Look forward to great training, rewarding work and unforgettable experiences and valuable qualifications.

We are looking for strong team players and effective communicators to become a part of our business, as well as individuals with new and innovative ideas to help build a stronger future for not only National Highways, but for themselves too.

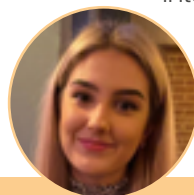
